1. This chart serves as a daily program guide for the different sessions during the 13th International Symposium on Victimology. The sections with blue-colored headings represent plenary sessions and contain the name of the keynote speaker, Chair, and the keynote address title. The sections with yellow headings represent the parallel sessions, which contain the individual participant oral presentations. The Parallel Sessions are organized according to number, and show the session's room number, title, chair, and individual presenters. Presenters are listed by last name and abstract number.

While this program largely reflects the actual program that will take place during the symposium, there is still a possibility that changes will be made. The Symposium Organizers reserve the right to reschedule session times and individual oral presentations. Final changes to the program will be represented in the Program Book available at on-site registration on August 23.

2. Oral presenters that plan to make a presentation using PowerPoint or any other PC-based program are asked to bring their presentation file on a USB Flash Drive (Memory Stick) to their assigned presentation room 20 minutes before the scheduled presentation time. Here, presenters must check in with their session chairs and give their presentation file to symposium staff to be loaded onto the presentation room computers.

3. Poster sessions will take place simultaneously to the morning and afternoon Parallel Sessions on Tuesday, Aug. 25. Poster presenters are asked to go to the Poster Session Hall (R Building Lobby) on Monday, Aug. 24, between 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. to set up their pre-printed presentation material on the university-provided board.
