

Information for Poster Presenters

Poster Presentations will be held at assigned times in assigned locations during the 13th International Symposium on Victimology. The Poster Presentations will be held parallel to other Parallel Sessions.

Applications to present a poster can be made by submitting your abstract online and selecting the option, "Poster Presentation" on your application (see "Submissions for Oral and Poster Presentations" on the symposium website's Call for Papers page). In your abstract, you are asked to identify the topic and the content of your poster presentation. Please note that submission of an abstract does not guarantee that you will be included in the program; submitters will be given confirmation notice as to whether or not they have been accepted after the abstract has been reviewed by the Scientific Program Committee. **The deadline for abstract submissions is June 20, 2009.**

The conference organizers will provide a site for your presentation, including an 832mm x 1640mm (32.7in. x 64.5in.) wall panel on to which you can hang your poster(s); the size and number of posters you would like to present is up to you, as long as they fit on the provided panel. (Generally speaking, a single panel can hold the equivalent of 18 sheets of regular sized (A4) paper.)
