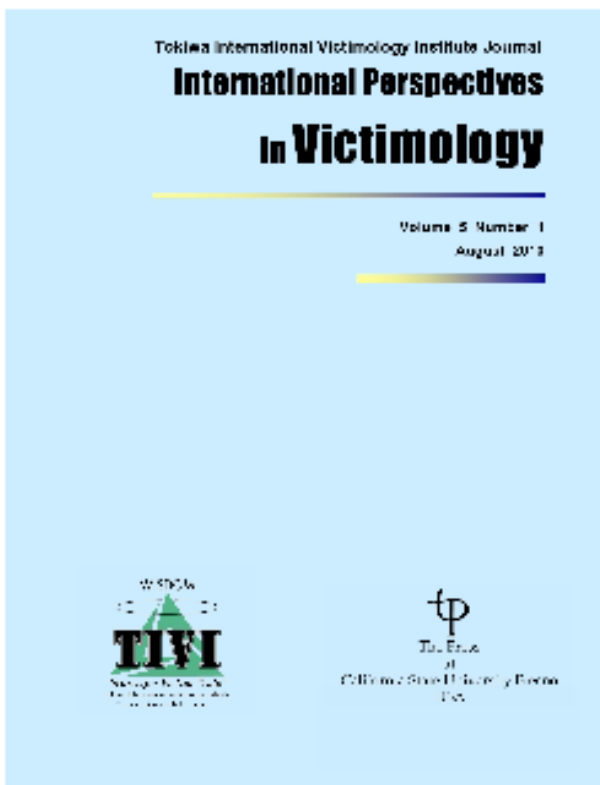


International Perspectives in Victimology
